Self-learning modules have been developed to support private study in specific subjects, and these can be attached to the face-to-face coaching sessions if required.

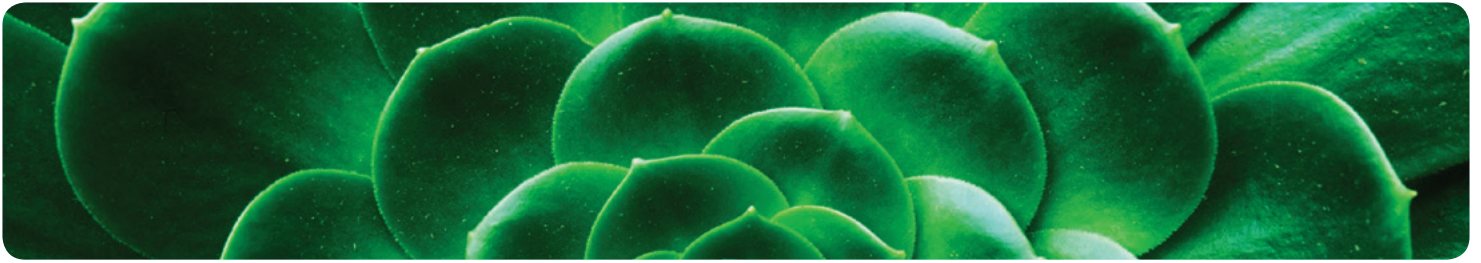
Team to team, AVA™

Technical coaching for teams has been run in the form of asset reviews using the Asset Value Assurance (AVA™) process developed by the TRACS

consultancy teams. These have been run for client teams requiring an interactive, independent review of their work with external facilitation. The AVA™ process brings together the deep, asset-specific experience of the client team with the broad cross-industry experience from the TRACS reservoir and wells consultancy groups. The composition of the AVA™ team is specified by the client according to the needs of the asset.

Team building

Non-technical team coaching has also been delivered in the form of team-building programmes. These can be run indoors or outdoors and are highly interactive. Team-building sessions are often integrated into broader programmes, such as planning workshops, business simulations or courses from the technical Series. The courses can be run residentially to provide an opportunity for teams to work together in an out-of-office social environment.
