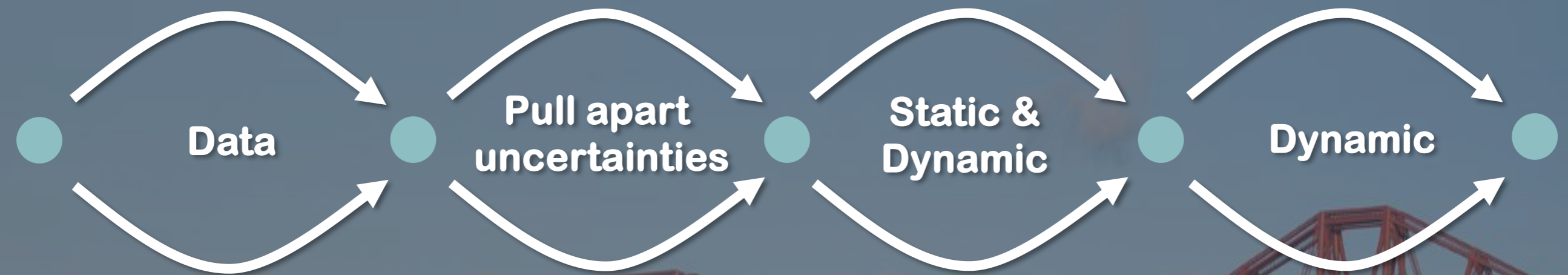

The iterative, parallel working approach to projects, is an alternative way of structuring and managing projects compared to a sequential discipline approach, as commonly captured on Gantt charts.

In this structure, most disciplines are active at most stages and the nodal points are effectively go/no go gates which the team passes through together with review.
