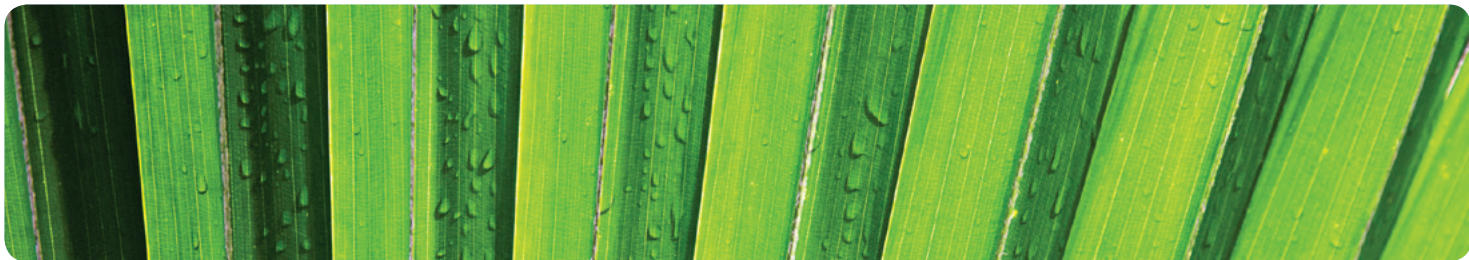
The Wells Series includes technical courses from introductory drilling and well planning to completion-related courses.
